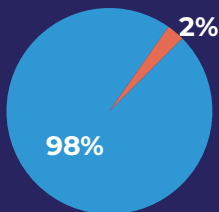

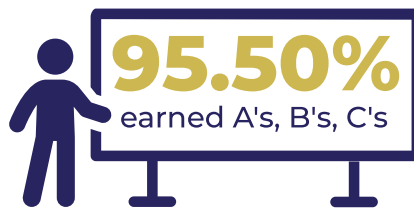

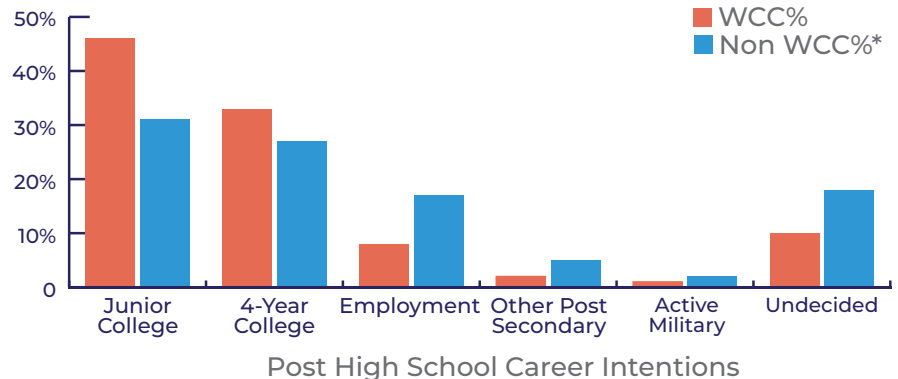
WCC STUDENT GRADES EARNED
